



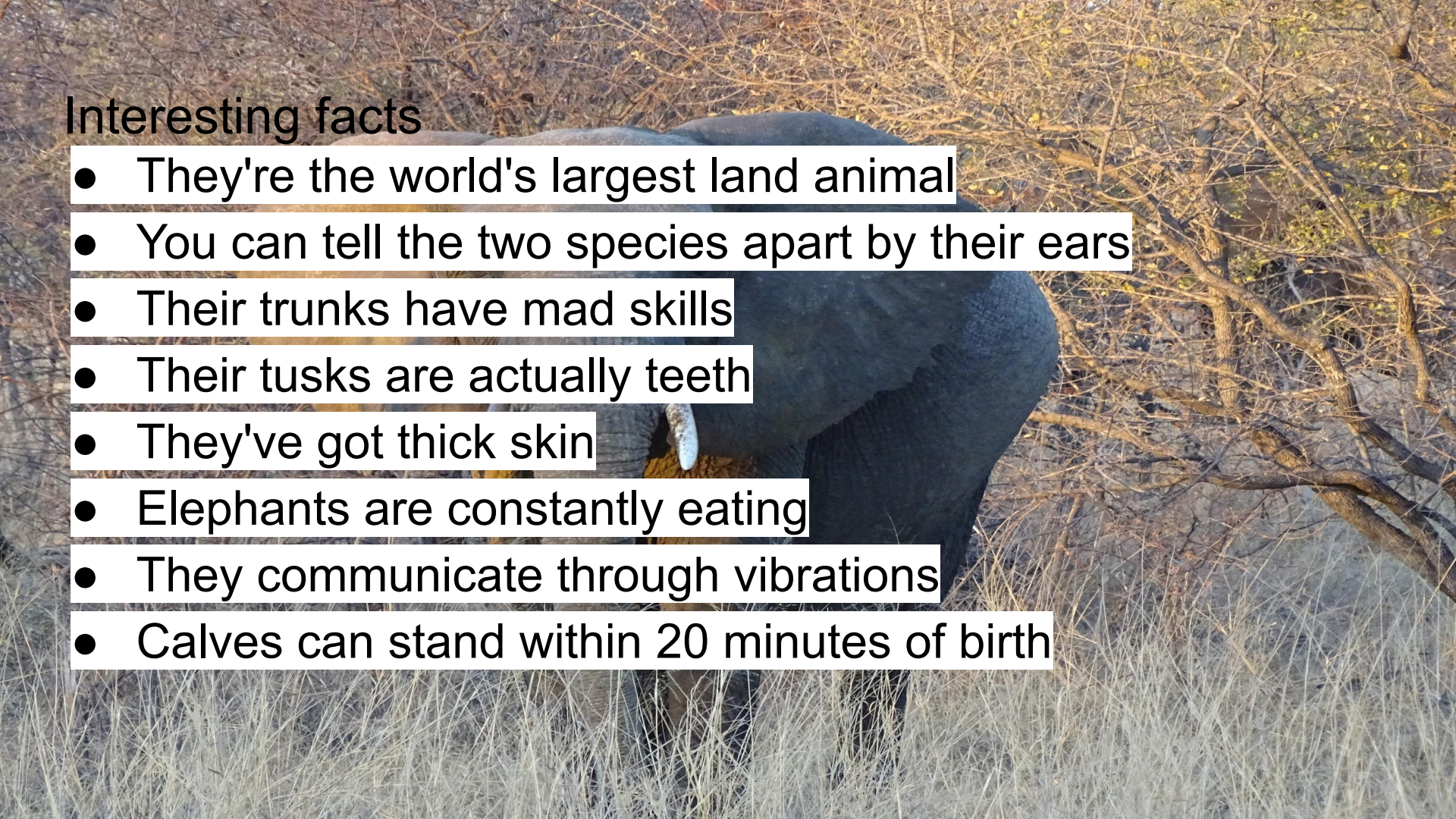
# Elephants!

## Interesting facts

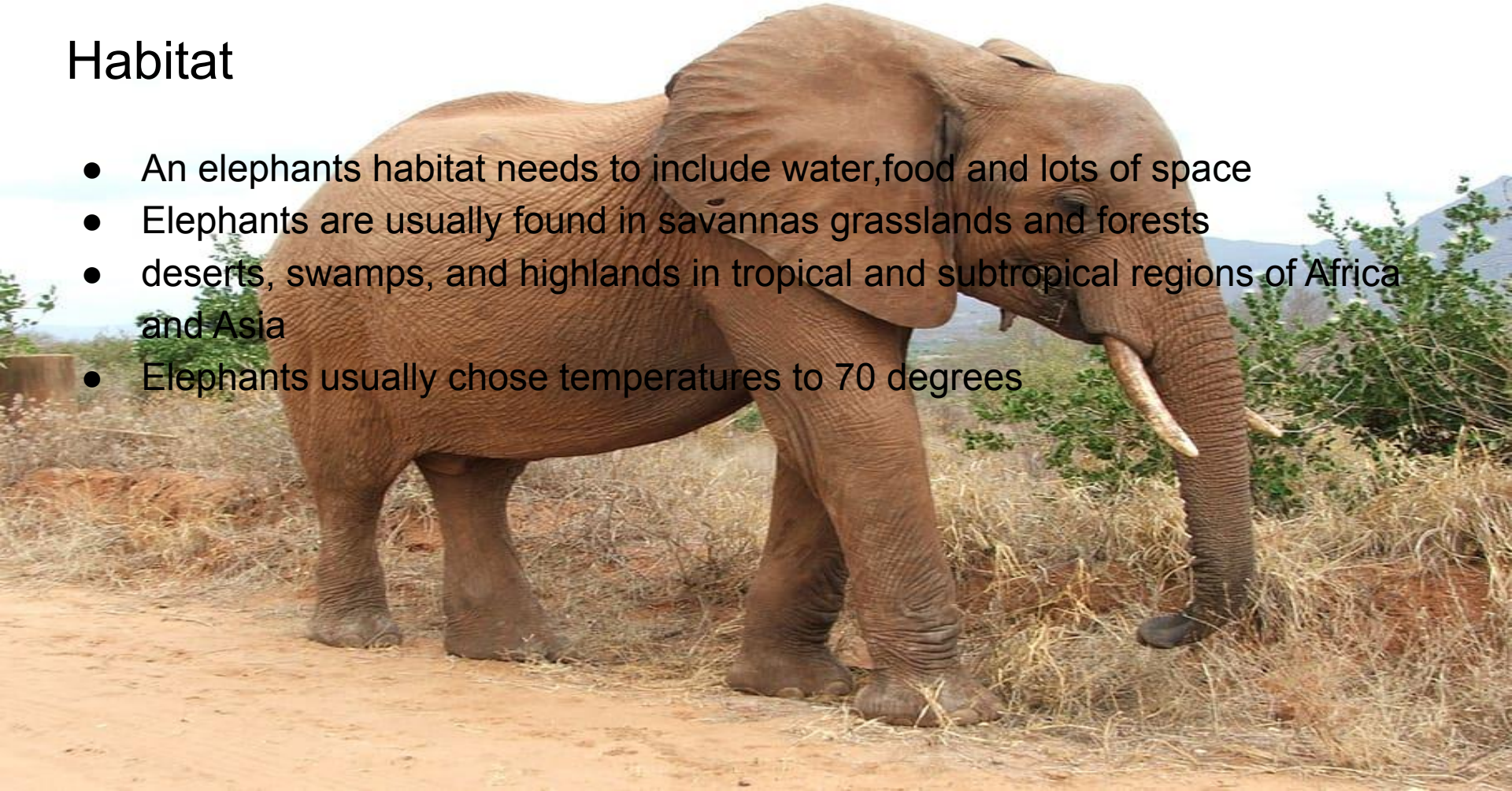
- They're the world's largest land animal
- You can tell the two species apart by their ears
- Their trunks have mad skills
- Their tusks are actually teeth
- They've got thick skin
- Elephants are constantly eating
- They communicate through vibrations
- Calves can stand within 20 minutes of birth





# Habitat

- An elephants habitat needs to include water, food and lots of space
- Elephants are usually found in savannas grasslands and forests
- deserts, swamps, and highlands in tropical and subtropical regions of Africa and Asia
- Elephants usually chose temperatures to 70 degrees



# Food

- Elephants are strict herbivores
- They eat roots, grass, leaves, plants and hay
- They eat 300 pounds of food a day
- They will eat up to 200 species of plants
- Elephants can eat an average of 150-160 kg of food in a day





# Why elephants are endangered

- We use elephants tusks to make jewelry
- We cut down trees so they don't have any habitat
- We hunt them





# How can we prevent elephants from being extinct

- We can stop hunting them
- Stop cutting trees
- Stop buying jewelry that uses elephant tusks



# Population

- There are approximately 415,000 elephants in the world
- People think in 2 decades if we don't do anything about elephant population they will go extinct
