Right now bees are dying in huge numbers because of global warming the flowers they prefer bloom at a different time they come out


Bees are everywhere and they collect pollen from specific types of flowers that are native to their land

- Diseases like american foulbrood are destroying larvae



How can we prevent bees from being extinct?

- You have to stop global warming so the right flowers appear at the right time
- Plant more flowers close to beehives
- Don't spray pesticide or any hazardous compounds
- More bee farms!

- Only 2 Billion Bees are left in the wild

Honey bee population = increasing

European dark bee population = decreasing

African/killer/africanized bee population = decreasing

Italian bee population = increasing

Russian honey bee population = decreasing

Cape honey bee population = decreasing
