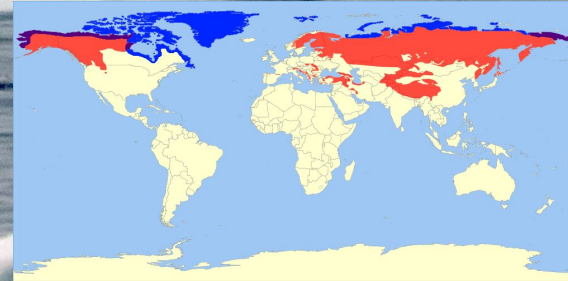
# Polar bear

# Habitat

- Polar bear lives at the arctic
- They prefer glaciers near the Arctic Ocean
- They live in Alaska, Canada , Russia, Greenland, and Norway
- They will climb onto sea ice to hunt food





# Food

- Polar Bears usually eat seals
- They wait at a seal breathing hole for the seal to come up
- The bear use its nose to sense out when the seal breathes
- Polar Bears use their sharp claws to draw the seal on the ice



# Why polar bears are endangered

- We hunted them
- Ice in the arctic is melting due to climate change so they have to swim long distances
- We used pesticides that made polar bears sick
- Oil spills get concentrated in the polar bears habitat





# How can we prevent Polar bears from being extinct

- We can stop hunting them
- We can prevent oil spills
- We could stop using pesticides



# Population

- There are 22,000 to 31,000 Polar bears left in the world
- There are 19 Polar bear subpopulations in the world
